N# Spring School on Advanced Signal Processing Techniques for Heterogeneous Networks

March 18-20, 2014 | Pisa, Italy

School premises

The school will take place at the premises of the *Centro di ricerca matematica "E. De Giorgi"*, located in the very heart of the city of Pisa (address: Palazzo del Castelletto, Via del Castelletto 11, Pisa). For further information, please visit the website www.crm.sns.it/. All lectures will be given in the room "Ulisse Dini" (crm.sns.it/classroom/9/).

How to get there by plane

The nearest airport to get to Pisa is Pisa International Airport "Galileo Galilei" (www.pisa-airport.com), which is located around 5 km from the city center and the premises of the school (Centro di ricerca matematica "E. De Giorgi", <http://www.crm.sns.it/practical/maps.html>). Another option is the Florence Intl. Airport "Amerigo Vespucci" (www.aeroporto.firenze.it).

From Pisa Airport

The easiest way to get to the Centro de Giorgi is to take a taxi just outside the airport for a cost of approximately €10. As an alternative, immediately next to the airport you will notice a little train station: every twenty minutes a train leaves in order to connect Pisa Airport to Pisa Central Station (Pisa Centrale) (five-minute trip), where you will find bus coincidences to the city center (www.cpt.pisa.it), or you can just walk (15-minute walk).

From Florence Airport

The easiest way to get to the Centro de Giorgi is again to take a taxi outside the airport, but for a cost of no less than €80. The cheapest alternative is to go to the Main Railway Station (Firenze Santa Maria Novella, S.M.N.), in order to take a train coincidence to Pisa. The recommended way is to take a taxi to the station. You can also use city buses: there is a bus leaving every 30 minutes from the airport to Firenze S.M.N. and you can get more information at www.ataf.net. At Firenze S.M.N. Station, there are trains to Pisa every half an hour (see www.trenitalia.com). The whole journey (bus+train) will take approximately two hours (for a cost of about €8).

How to get there by train

All trains stop at Pisa Central Station (Pisa Centrale). For more information, visit www.trenitalia.com. You can either take a taxi to the Centro de Giorgi (approximate fare of €5), or just walk (15-minute walk). You can also stop at Pisa San Rossore, a minor railway station, where you can again take a cab or walk to the school premises (15-minute walk).

How to get there by car

From Northern Italy: Highway A12 (Genova-Rosignano), exit at Pisa Nord

From Southern Italy: Highway A12 (Genova-Rosignano), exit at Pisa Centro

From Eastern Italy: Highway A11 (Firenze-Mare), exit at Pisa Nord
